

PAPER INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE III EUROPEAN CONFERENCE ON COMPUTATIONAL SOLID AND STRUCTURAL MECHANICS

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Keywords: Instructions, ECCOMAS Conference, Computational Mechanics, Multibody Dynamics, Proceedings.

Abstract: This document provides information and instructions for preparing a paper to be included in the Proceedings of the III European Conference on Computational Solid and Structural Mechanics. The paper can be written in *Latin* or *English*. The first page is reserved for the title of the paper, the authors, affiliation, key words and the Abstract. The introduction must begin at the top of the second page. All the instructions as well as the source for the example files for *Latin* or *English* can be found in the website of the Congress.

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1 INTRODUCTION

The proceedings will be edited in a CD-ROM, including the texts and figures, using Postscript Document Format (PDF). The paper should be written following the format of the *Latin* and *English* manuals for submission that can be found in the Conference website. The file has to be translated to Portable Document Format (PDF) before submission. Authors should submit the paper electronically as an archive file (using Zip or any other equivalent program) that must contain the PDF document and the original *Word* or *Latex* files and figures used for the manuscript. The organizers do not consider themselves to include in the Proceedings any paper received later than the official deadline. At least one of the authors must register and pay further registration fees before the deadline for their paper to be included in the final program of the Congress.

In addition to the CD-ROM, a book of one-page abstracts will be edited containing the basic information about each paper to be presented at the Congress. Note that these instructions are for submitted manuscripts and not for the invited lectures. The manuscript supporting the invited lectures have a different format.

2 GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

The paper must be written in English within a printing box of 16 cm x 24 cm, centered in the page. The paper including figures, tables and references must have a maximum length of 4 pages and must not exceed 20 pages.

3 TITLE, AUTHORS, AFFILIATION, KEYWORDS

The first page must contain the Title, Author(s), Affiliation(s), Keywords and the Abstract. The second page must begin with the Introduction. The first line of the title is located 3 cm from the top of the printing box.

3.1 Title

The title should be written, centered, in 14pt, boldface Roman, all capital letters. It should be single spaced if the title is more than one line long.

3.2 Author

The author's name should include first name, middle initial and surname. It should be written, centered, in 12pt boldface Roman, 12pt below the title.

3.3 Affiliation

Author's affiliation should be written, centered, in 12pt Roman, 12pt below the list of authors. A 12pt space should separate two different affiliations.

3.4 Keywords

Please, write no more than six key words, which will be used to compile the CD-ROM indexes. They should be written 8pt slanted, in 12pt Roman, and the line must begin with the word **Key words:** boldfaced. A 12pt space should separate the key words from the affiliation.
